## THE CONFERENCE

The President and Council of the European Society for Person Centered Healthcare are delighted to announce the dates and venue for the Fifth Annual Conference and Awards Ceremony of the European Society for Person Centered Healthcare (ESPCH5).

## ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

The Society is honoured to welcome distinguished speakers from the USA, Canada, Australia, Portugal, Bulgaria, Romania, Italy, Denmark, Germany, United Kingdom, The Netherlands and France.

Over the course of the two days, ESPCH5 will discuss and debate a range of areas of contemporary concern in person-centered care including, but not limited to the following:

- Defining elements of person-centered care for therapeutic relationships
- Resilience – that of institutions as well as of patients
- New visions for person-centered mental health services
- Meanings of participation in hospital care - as narrated by patients
- The subjective experience of Parkinson's disease: A qualitative study in 60 people with mild to moderate Parkinson's in 11 European countries
- Self-Management Open Online Trials in Health (SMOOTH): Methods and public involvement survey of corresponding authors of existing online trials
- An integrated model of care for young people with liver disease and transplant
- The dangers of risk classification in PCC
- Developing a new questionnaire to measure nurse caring behaviours: a mixed method study
- How systematic learning from significant medical events can safeguard patients and promote PCC.
- Goal-oriented deliberative fora in PCC
- The problem of disease stigma
- The role of big data and precision medicine in PCC
- Address the practical challenges of providing person-centered dementia care.
- Personalised decision support at the end of life
- A new postgraduate package of education for equipping practitioners and others in how to 'do' PCC within time and resource constrained modern health system settings (developed by UWL in association with ESPCH)
- Burn out – in institutions as well as professionals
- Why every healthcare consultation needs a dose of empathy
- Contextualizing the GRADE System – can the general be particularised?
